To be considered for a City of Owensboro Firefighter position,
you must successfully complete ALL of the following:

1. Apply with the City of Owensboro by submitting a CITY OF OWENSBORO Application for Employment ("job application") by the application deadline of March 2, 2018, by following the instructions below; AND
2. Obtain your valid CPAT card PRIOR to May 23, 2018, for admission to written exam, and maintain it going forward, by following the instructions below; AND
3. Applicants meeting our job requirements, who have also met the above two requirements, may be considered to participate in one or more portions of the remaining recruitment process (dates subject to change), such as:
 - ◇ MANDATORY Written Exam: May 23, 2018 at 9:00am OR 5:30pm (hold both times); and, if you pass, then
 - ◇ MANDATORY Oral exam, between June 11-15, 2018; and, if you successfully complete, then you may undergo
 - ◇ MANDATORY Further Evaluation (e.g., Background screening, interview, etc.), dates to be determined, and if contingently offered a position, then
 - ◇ MANDATORY satisfactory completion of post-offer, pre-employment requirements, dates to be determined.

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO APPLY

APPLICATION DEADLINE: MARCH 2, 2018

TO APPLY: To ensure your application will be considered, it must be received **NO LATER than March 2, 2018**. Visit www.owensboro.org. Click "Employment Opportunities"; click on the position; follow directions on how to apply (i.e., in upper right-hand corner, click "Download Application" to download and complete application electronically; Save; then click arrow in very upper left-hand corner to go back to previous page; Click "Submit Application" and complete required information; Submit; You should receive a message telling you if your application was successfully submitted). If you experience difficulty, you may also email your job application and any related documentation directly to timmelme@owensboro.org. Resume alone is NOT sufficient.**

CPAT: All Kentucky career firefighter candidates are required to undergo a physical ability test (i.e., "CPAT"). The Kentucky Fire Commission administers this testing. We are fortunate that in 2018, CPAT testing will be offered locally in Owensboro for those applying for the position of City of Owensboro Firefighter. Only qualified applicants meeting our requirements will be admitted for CPAT testing. If you are not available to attend the Owensboro CPAT, you may inquire about the possibility of participating at a different location (i.e., Winchester, KY, between Mar. 19 and May 14). The CPAT requirements will be held in Owensboro, KY, on the following dates (HOLD all dates, all day):

March 17, 2018, 8am, Orientation (MANDATORY)

April 14, 2018, 8am, 1st Practice (MANDATORY unless waived pursuant to CPAT requirements)

April 28, 2018, 8am, 2nd Practice (MANDATORY unless waived pursuant to CPAT requirements)

May 12, 2018, 8am, Final Exam ("CPAT") (MANDATORY)

- ◇ Valid CPAT card may be accepted in lieu of above CPAT process. Valid CPAT card REQUIRED for admittance to written exam. If CPAT is valid at time of written exam, but expires before date of hire, you will be required to renew it prior to any further consideration.
